3. In the G.O. 4<sup>th</sup> read above, orders were issued for retaining the existing fee structure for the Undergraduate Medical / Dental courses in private Unaided Minority Colleges, duly retaining the terms & conditions laid in G.O.3<sup>rd</sup> read above.

4. In the G.O. 5<sup>th</sup> read above for the academic year 2017-18, orders were issued for Undergraduate Medical / Dental Courses, increasing 5 % tuition fee for category B seats and in respect of C category, the fee shall not exceed two (2) times of “B” category seats for the academic year 2017-18 for Private Unaided Non-Minority Colleges.

5. In the reference 6<sup>th</sup> read above, Telangana Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee, Hyderabad submitted its recommendations for fixation of fee structure for M.B.B.S, B.D.S courses for the block period 2020-2023 and requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

6. Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby decide to retain the existing fee structure for the Undergraduate Medical and Dental Courses in Private Unaided Non-Minority, Minority Medical and Dental Colleges and also Army College of Dental Sciences for the year 2020-2021 in view of the special circumstances due to COVID-19 pandemic, duly retaining the terms and conditions laid in G.O. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> read above.

7. The Registrar, KNR University Health Sciences, Warangal, Principals of all the Private Unaided Non-Minority, Minority Medical and Dental Colleges and Army College of Dental Sciences, Secunderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.

**ORDER:**

In pursuance of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 12/08/2005 in Appeal (civil) No. 5041 of 2005 filed by P.A. Inamdar Vs. State of Maharashtra (AIR 2005 SC 3226), the Supreme Court has directed to constitute a committee headed by a retired Judge of High Court for fixation of fee for the students admitted into Un-aided Private Professional Education Institutions (Minority and Non-Minority).

In pursuance of the above orders of Supreme Court of India, Government in the G.O.12<sup>th</sup> read above, constituted an Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee under the Chairmanship of Justice Sri P. Swaroop Reddy (Retired Judge of High Court for the States of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana) for matters relating to fee fixation in Private Un-aided Professional Colleges in the State.

The Telangana State Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee has reported that the Committee deliberated on the fee arrived for different Medical and Dental Colleges based on the information submitted by Medical and Dental Colleges and intimated / recommended the same to the Government, vide their letter 13<sup>th</sup> read above.

The Government after careful examination of the matter hereby order that the fee structure and certain directions connected thereto as indicated in the annexure to this order shall be implemented by all the Private Un-aided Minority Medical and Dental Colleges. These orders are applicable to the Private Un-aided Minority Medical and Dental Professional Institutions in the State for the academic year 2016-17, and shall come into force with immediate effect.

The Principals of all Private Unaided Minority Medical / Dental Colleges shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.

2. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the President, Telangana Private Medical & Dental Management Association has requested to revise the existing fee structure keeping in view of the financial constraints of the education institution for the academic year 2017-18.

The Government after careful examination of the matter hereby decided not to increase the fee for Category A seats, Government also decided to increase 5 % tuition fee for category B seats and in respect of C category, the fee shall not exceed two (2) times of "B" Category seats for the present academic year 2017-18 and order that the fee structure shall be implemented by all the Private Un-aided Non-Minority Medical and Dental Colleges duly following the directions mentioned in G.O. 1<sup>st</sup> read above. These orders are applicable to the Private Un-aided Non-Minority Medical and Dental Professional Institutions in the State for the academic year 2017-18, and shall come into force with immediate effect.
